<b>Media Synopsis:</b> <hr/> <p>On October 11th, 2014, a dispute erupted between various members and associates of the Blevins and Garrett families at the Lavish Ultra Lounge Hookah Bar at 3654 West 117th Street in Cleveland.</p> <p>The dispute spilled outside into the parking lot where shots were fired. Barry Blevins shot and killed David Garrett and disposed of the weapon in a nearby backyard. On June 16, 2016, Lindon was found guilty of Theft, Drug Possession and Tampering with Evidence.
