Media Synopsis:

The State of Ohio charges that on Feb. 5, 2015, defendant Shine, then 20 years old, entered the Chalk Linez barber shop on Harvard Avenue in Warrensville Heights and fatally shot three victims: Walter Barfield, 23; Brandon White Ladson, 31; and William Gonzalez, 32. He also shot and severely wounded three other victims.

In addition, the State charges that defendant Shine arranged for the June 4, 2015 murder of Aaron (Pudge) Ladson, 32, whose brother was among February's victims. Mr. Ladson was on his way to Common Pleas Court in an unrelated case when he was shot outside his house on Harvard Avenue in Warrensville Heights.

The State also charges that in January of 2015, defendant Shine attempted to murder two other individuals and fired bullets into an occupied house and a school.

The State of Ohio is seeking the death penalty in this case.

Trial is set to begin at 9 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On Feb. 11, 2016, defendant Farmer, then 30, knocked on the door of the 81-year-old victim who lived in Berea. When she opened the door, he forced his way into the apartment and raped her. As the victim tried to fight off her attacker, she told him that if he stopped she would give him all the money she had. He took her \$7 in cash and before leaving warned her not to tell anyone what had happened. A rape kit was collected at Southwest General Hospital, and it contained a DNA profile that matched to the defendant.

On August 31, defendant Farmer entered a plea of guilty to three counts of Rape as well as Kidnapping (with a sexual motivation specification) and Aggravated Burglary.

Sentencing is set for 9:30 a.m.
