REPORT IT



If you see, hear or experience cyberbullying, inappropriate sexual posts or messages, or any other behavior that makes you feel uncomfortable, immediately tell a parent, teacher or trusted adult.

Anything you post online can be seen by anyone.

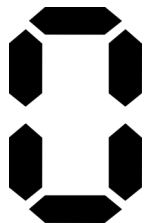
Deleting it from your phone does not guarantee that it is gone forever.
