### Media Synopsis:

On April 12, 2011, Price, 29, of Cleveland, sexually assaulted a 25-year-old female victim at her residence in Euclid. Price was at the victim's house visiting when he told her he wanted to have sex. When the victim refused, Price carried her upstairs and forcibly removed her clothing. Later that same month, the victim made another complaint against Price for harassing her by telephone.

Price was found guilty by a jury of one counts of Kidnapping, one count of Rape, and one count of Telecommunications Harassment. On May 14, 2012 Price was sentenced to six years in prison. This sentence ran consecutively to the 10 years to life sentence imposed in case CR 558932 where Price was found guilty by a jury of one count of Kidnapping.

This case was returned to the docket by the order of the court of appeals. Trial is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

### Media Synopsis:

Jones, 43, of Lakewood, was arrested after two teenage girls, one 13 and the other 16, disclosed to a sex abuse worker that Jones had been having sexual relations with them for the past few years. Jones has denied all allegations; however, the Ohio Internet Crimes Against Children Taskforce was able to retrieve a video he created which depicts in graphic detail the rape and abuse of one of the teenage girls. On March 24, 2013, Jones entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Rape, Sexual Battery and Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

He lost control of the vehicle and crashed into a tree. Of the four passengers in the vehicle, one rear passenger, William Fekete, 22 died from his injuries sustained from the impact. Two of the three remaining passengers were seriously injured. The driver and occupants of the vehicle belonged to a car club called Adrenaline Obsessions. Trial is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

<p><b>Media Synopsis:</b></p> <p>On April 22, 2013, as a means of discipline, Domonique Jones, then 28, of Cleveland, tied her 9-year old daughter to a chair using belts. Jones then began whipping the victim with a belt over her entire body including her face. Jones had called the father of her children to come over and help discipline the child. The father showed up at the same time as Jones' boyfriend, co-defendant Joe McCurdy III of Cleveland. When the father saw what was happening he immediately called police. The two suspects continued whipping the child as well as the victim's 7-year old brother who was trying to protect his sister. McCurdy plead guilty to one count of Endangering Children and was sentenced to one year in prison. On February 6, 2014, Jones entered a plea of guilty to two counts of Attempted Endangering Children and one count of Endangering Children. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.</p>

**Media Synopsis:**

On September 3, 2011, Taylor, of Cleveland, who was 17-years-old at the time of the incident, sexually assaulted the then 11-year-old female victim. Taylor entered the bedroom of the victim while she was asleep and sexually assaulted her. After the sexual assault, the suspect told the victim not to tell anyone or he'll hurt members of her family and exited her bedroom. She later told family members what had happened and the police were contacted. On February 20, 2014, Taylor was found guilty by a jury of one count each of Rape and Kidnapping. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 am.
