**Media Synopsis:**

On March 23, 2017, 24-year-old Dukes and 30-year-old Teal went to Beachwood Mall to sell a large amount of marijuana. During the transaction, the deal turned into an attempted robbery by the buyers of the marijuana. Teal was shot and returned fire; he was struck in the back and is now paralyzed. The drugs and a gun were recovered at the scene, and the unknown buyers remain at large.

On May 29, 2017, the defendant, 37, was speeding on East 93rd Street in Cleveland when he struck a male victim, 63, and female victim, 55, who were crossing the street. Both victims died at the scene. The defendant did not stop or call for help. His SUV was later found hidden in his garage with a blanket over the damaged front end.
