On February 26, 2016, a Metro health Social Worker received an anonymous call from a male requesting a welfare check on a woman in Fairview Park. Fairview Park Police entered the home and found the woman, 32, deceased from injuries.

On November 30, a jury found her live-in boyfriend, 41-year-old Bey, guilty Murder, Felonious Assault, Involuntary Manslaughter, Failing to Provide for a Functionally Impaired Person, Domestic Violence, and Assault.

On September 27, 2017, 37-year-old Tillie entered the Citizen's Bank on St. Clair and gave the teller a threatening note demanding money. The teller complied and when the defendant tried to flee the bank, she became trapped between the security doors.
