On June 12, 2017, a jury found Lindsey guilty of Murder, Attempted Murder, Felonious Assault, Discharge of Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises, Improper Discharging Firearm At or Into Habitation or School, Improper Handling Firearms in a Motor Vehicle, Tampering with Evidence, Arson, and Having Weapons while under Disability. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m.

Media Synopsis:

On November 18, 2016, the defendants, both 18, along with two juveniles trespassed onto First Energy property at East 146th Street. The suspects ran after Cleveland Police showed up on the scene and defendant Gideon began firing at the officers. The officers returned fire and defendant Williams was shot in the leg.

On June 1, 2017, Williams pled guilty to Felonious Assault of a Peace Officer and Breaking and Entering.

Blevins, Barry | Blevins, Jean

Media Synopsis:

On October 11th, 2014, a dispute erupted between various members and associates of the Blevins and Garrett families at the Lavish Ultra Lounge Hookah Bar on West 117th Street in Cleveland. The dispute spilled outside into the parking lot where shots were fired.

Barry Blevins, then 30, shot and killed the victim, David Garrett, 26, and disposed of the weapon in a nearby backyard. Immediately preceding the fatal shot, Barry's brother, Jean Blevins, then 25, was seen handing Barry the firearm.

In August of 2016, Barry pled guilty to Voluntary Manslaughter and received a 14-year sentence.

On June 14, 2017, a jury found Jean guilty of Felonious Assault, Involuntary Manslaughter, Aggravated Assault, and Having Weapons While Under Disability.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m.
