Media Synopsis:

On October 23, 2014, Pawlak, 26, of Cleveland, crashed into the Dover Gardens Tavern in Westlake after losing control of a stolen vehicle during a high speed chase that began in Avon. As a result, 13 people were injured and transported to the hospital. Sowden, also 26 and of Cleveland, assisted Pawlak in stealing the vehicle. Trial is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

On July 30, 2015, Pawlak was found guilty by a jury of 13 counts of Aggravated Robbery, 13 counts of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, two counts of Grand Theft, one count of Failure to Comply, and one count of Breaking and Entering. He was sentenced to 35 years and six months.

On August 3, 2015, Sowden entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Breaking and Entering and Grand Theft. He is scheduled to be sentenced at 9:00 a.m.
