Media Synopsis: On March 10, 2012, Johnson, then 20, of Cleveland, was stopped by Cleveland Police on a traffic violation and found to be driving under suspension. Johnson was traveling southbound on East 156th Street from Lakeshore Boulevard when he made a sudden turn onto Grovewood Avenue without using his turn signal. While searching the vehicle, police located a white plastic bag containing \$3,723 in cash under the front seat passenger side. While in the back of the police vehicle, Johnson stated to several officers, "You guys can take all the money. I won't say anything. Just give me a ticket, tow the car and let me walk, and the money is yours, this is not necessary." Johnson was subsequently arrested. On September 1, 2015, Johnson entered a plea of guilty to one count of Attempted Bribery. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:15 a.m.

The victim died from his injuries. On August 20, 2015, both defendants entered a plea of guilty to one count of Voluntary Manslaughter. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

Media Synopsis: On March 12, 2015, Fox, 34, of Rocky River, struck the victim with his Chevy Silverado while the victim was walking to work. Fox slowed the vehicle, but did not stop and ultimately fled the scene. The victim sustained serious head and other injuries and was treated at MetroHealth Hospital. Fox was later seen at an auto repair shop having a head lamp assembled. He eventually admitted his involvement in the incident to the Brooklyn Police Department. On August 4, 2015, Fox entered a plea of one count each of Failure to Stop After Accident and Attempted Tampering With Evidence. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m.

On September 3, 2015, Franks was found guilty by a jury of one count each of Aggravated Murder, Murder, Aggravated Robbery, Kidnapping, Felonious Assault, Discharge of Firearm On Or Near Prohibited Premises and Tampering With Evidence. He is scheduled to be sentenced at 9:30 a.m. Coates is awaiting trial.
