Media Synopsis:

Jeffries, 18, Broderson, 24, Abrams, 20, Romeo Kibble, 19, Bates 19, Rodney Kibble, 23, and Watkins, 27, all of Cleveland, committed 18 armed robberies of businesses throughout Cuyahoga County between March and April 2015.

On July 7, 2015, Watkins entered a plea to one count of Obstructing Justice and was sentenced to nine months in prison.

Jeffries, Brodersen, Abrams, Romeo Kibble, Bates, and Rodney Kibble all entered pleas of guilty to various charged including Aggravated Robbery, Kidnapping, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Possessing Criminal Tools.

On October 15, 2015, Jeffries was sentenced to 9 years in prison; Broderson was sentenced to 29 years in prison; Abrams was sentenced to 28 years in prison; Rodney Kibble was sentenced to 30 years in prison.

Romeo Kibble is scheduled to be sentenced at 10 a.m., and Bates is scheduled to be sentenced at 1 p.m.
