Media Synopsis:
Hayman, 62, of Orange Village, befriended a 17-year-old girl online and began a sexual relationship with the teen. Hayman directed the creation of child pornography and downloaded child pornography online. Hayman also provided the girl with alcohol, marijuana, and pornography.
On October 1, 2015, Hayman entered a plea of guilty to five counts of Illegal Use of Minor in Nudity Oriented Material, two counts of Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, and one count each of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity Oriented Material, Corrupting Another with Drugs, Disseminating Matter Harmful to a Juvenile and Possessing Criminal Tools.
Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m.

On April 22, 2015, Jordan, 40, of Cleveland, fatally shot the 49-year-old victim in the vicinity of 2886 Woodhill Avenue in Cleveland.

On September 21, 2015, Jordan entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Voluntary Manslaughter, Aggravated Assault, Discharge of a Firearm, Having Weapons Under Disability and two counts of Endangering Children.

Media Synopsis:

On April 15, 2015, the 10-year-old victim was with Hurth, playing video games. Hurth was drinking. When the victim wanted to quit during a game, they began to argue and Hurth grabbed the victim by the shirt collar and ordered him to leave the house.

While the child was calling his mother, Hurth grabbed the phone, ended the call and then shoved the victim into the wall and put his hands around his neck and threw him onto the bed. He then punched him in the back and hit him in the head with an open hand.

Hurth, 47, of Cleveland, has five prior DV convictions.

Media Synopsis:

On February 12, 2014, Keith, then 17, of Cleveland, and three other co-defendant's saw the victim at a gas station on the east side of Cleveland. Keith and his co-defendant followed the victim and two other people as they were driving on Interstate 480. The group pulled alongside of the car and began firing into the victim's car. No one was hurt during the shooting.

Six months later, on August 7, 2014, Keith and two other males were riding their bikes when they saw the victim, Arturo Young, and his friends walking down the street. Keith produced a firearm and shot and killed the victim.

The jury convicted Parr of two counts of Felonious Assault, and one count of Domestic Violence.

Media Synopsis:

On April 7, 2015, the 76-year-old victim was found deceased in her home by family. Police were notified and after assessing the crime scene, it was revealed that a break in occurred and the victim was stabbed and beaten to death.

DNA collected from the crime scene returned a link to Campbell, 47, of Cleveland. Campbell was a former tenant of the victim.

On September 18, 2015, Campbell entered a plea of guilty to one count of Murder and two counts each of Aggravated Murder, Aggravated Burglary and Felonious Assault.
