Media Synopsis:

The defendants, ranging in age from 17 to 34, all of Cleveland, were affiliated with the BBE/900 gang based on the west side of Cleveland.

Several defendants pled guilty and were sentenced on an earlier date, including Manning, 17, who pled to one count of Voluntary Manslaughter and was sentenced to 31 years in prison.

On October 26, 2015, Cistrunk, 20, entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Participating In A Criminal Gang, Felonious Assault and Burglary.

Sentencing for Cistrunk is scheduled to begin at 11:00 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

William Waters, 39, of Westlake, was accused of raping underaged females between 1999 and 2014.

After one of victims reported the sexual assaults to the Westlake Police Department in June of 2014, William Waters fled Ohio. Cheryl Waters, 62, of Westlake, aided him in his flight from law enforcement and was charged with Endangering Children and Obstructing Justice.

William Waters was apprehended in October of 2014 in Fort Smith, Arkansas, by the US Marshalls with numerous electronic devices and items of child pornography in his possession.

On July 9, 2015, Cheryl Waters entered a plea of guilty to one count of Obstructing Justice and will be sentenced on December 7.

On November 17, 2015, a jury found William Waters III guilty of more than three dozen counts including charges of Kidnapping, Rape, Attempted Rape, Gross Sexual Imposition, Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor and Illegal Use of Minor in Nudity Oriented Material or Performance.

His sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On June 13, 2015, Watts, 31 invited the then 36-year-old victim to his Lakewood apartment. He was sleeping when she arrived, but when he woke up, found her talking to his roommate. Apparently jealous, he punched the victim multiple times. She was rushed to the hospital unconscious, and placed on life support. Victim still suffers memory loss and speech problems due to brain trauma suffered in the attack.

On October 19, defendant Watts pled guilty to Felonious Assault with a Repeat Violent Offender specification. His prior convictions include Burglary, Gross Sexual Imposition, Aggravated Robbery and Violating a Protection Order.

Sentencing is set for 10 a.m.
