From July 31 through August 1, 2015, Holko, 31, of Southington, sold fentanyl laced heroin to the victim, at a Howard Johnson's Motel in Brookpark. The victim subsequently died of a fatal overdose.

Stroud, Holko's girlfriend, was caught with a personal amount of fentanyl. She pled guilty to one Drug Possession count and was admitted into the Intervention In Lieu of Conviction Program.

Waters, Cheryl | Waters, William, III | Waters, Heather

Media Synopsis:

William Waters, 39, of Westlake, was accused of sexually assaulting juvenile females between 1999 and 2014.

After one of victims reported the sexual assaults to the Westlake Police Department in June of 2014, William Waters fled to Sallisaw, Oklahoma. Cheryl Waters, 63, of Westlake, aided him in his flight from law enforcement and on July 9, 2015, pled guilty to one count of Obstructing Justice.

William Waters was apprehended in October of 2014 in Fort Smith Arkansas by the US Marshalls with numerous electronic devices and items of child pornography in his possession. On, November 25, 2015, he was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

Cheryl Waters is scheduled to be sentenced at 9:00 a.m.

Moser, Gregory K.

Media Synopsis:

An Ohio Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force investigation initiated in April 2014, revealed that Moser, 28, of Strongsville, contacted the undercover profile of a 15 year-old female via a dating app on his cell phone. Moser expressed an interest in engaging in sex with the minor child, and sent several sexually charged images to the minor. On June 15, 2015, Moser traveled to a predetermined location to meet with whom he believed was a minor child to engage in sexual activity. He was arrested on site by the Ohio ICAC Task Force.

On October 29, 2015, Moser entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Importuning and Dissemination Matter Harmful to Juveniles.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:30 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On June 26, 2015, Livingston, 50, of Cleveland, was arrested for the rape of a 12-year old-boy. Livingston also took explicit photos of the juvenile victim. Wilson, 49, of Cleveland, was charged with Illegal Use Of Minor In Nudity-Oriented Material Or Performance for his involvement in the incident. Wilson pled guilty on November 18.

Livingston pled guilty to two counts of Rape on November 17. Following his plea, visiting Judge Michael E. Corrigan immediately sentenced Livingston to 20 years to life in prison. Upon his release, Livingston will be required to register as a Tier III sexual offender for the rest of his life.

Wilson is scheduled to be sentenced at 9:00 a.m.
