### Media Synopsis:

On December 17, 2015, Jimmie Jackson, now 50, pled guilty to two counts of rape and a sexually violent predator specification related to two home invasion rapes in 1998 and 2000.

On April 18, 1998 at about 3:50 am, Jimmie Jackson broke into the victim's apartment through a partially opened window while she was sleeping. He told her not to scream out and then he placed a two-pronged fork in her left ear and his right hand over her mouth. He then raped her. Because it was dark, the victim was never able to identify the man who attacked her.

On June 5, 2000, at about 2 am, Jackson broke into a 14-year-old victim's house while she was sleeping on a couch in the living room. He put his hand over her mouth, telling her not to scream or he would kill her, placed a pillow over her face and then raped her. The victim was not able to identify her attacker.

As a result of the Ohio Attorney General's Office's Sexual Assault Kit Testing Initiative, both rape kits were tested and Jimmie Jackson's DNA was discovered. Jimmie Jackson is currently in prison for similar home invasion rapes. He is facing a sentence of 10 years to life in prison.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m.

<b>Media Synopsis:</b> On June 3, 2015, Dejesus, then 26, of Cleveland, entered the victim's vehicle while it was stopped at a red light. Dejesus began assaulting the victim and ultimately caused him to crash his vehicle near Detroit Avenue and West Boulevard. The victim was transported to MetroHealth where he died from his injuries.  Dejesus waived his right to a jury trial. <b>Media Synopsis:</b> From July 31 through August 1, 2015, Holko, 31, of Southington, O., sold fentanyl to the victim at a Howard Johnson's motel in Brook Park. The victim died from a fatal overdose.  Stroud, Holko's girlfriend, was caught with a personal amount of fentanyl. She pled guilty to one Drug Possession count and was admitted into the Intervention In Lieu of Conviction Program.  On December 7, 2015, Holko entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Attempted Involuntary Manslaughter and Trafficking.  Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m.
