Media Synopsis:

On November 15, 2010, former North Olmsted Patrol Officer Brian Bielozer used the Ohio Law Enforcement Automated Data System ("LEADS") to look up personal information about his girlfriend's landlord

Bielozer, now 41, of Westlake, used the LEADS information to locate and travel to the landlord's home in Westlake at approximately 2:30 a.m. Wearing his uniform, Bielozer threatened to pursue a criminal case against the landlord if they didn't return money that Bielozer claimed was owed his girlfriend.

Camacho, Ismael | Galarza, Irving | Cruz-Figueroa, Luis

Media Synopsis:

Galarza, 45, of Cleveland, hired Camacho, 55, of Cleveland to enter and set a fire in an occupied two-family structure at 3857 West 33rd Street in Cleveland on February 10, 2015. Camacho in turn hired Cruz-Figueroa, 45, of Cleveland to assist him in setting the fire. The fire spread to two occupied structures on West 33rd Street resulting in severe damage to all three and necessitating the demolition of two of the three affected homes.

One of the occupants barely escaped; she subsequently spent nearly a year recovering from the injuries resulting from smoke inhalation and has permanent injuries.

On November 30, 2015, Camacho entered a plea of guilty to three counts of Aggravated Arson, and one count each of Felonious Assault and Tampering With Evidence. He will be sentenced at 9:00 a.m.

Both Galarza and Cruz-Figueroa are awaiting trial.
