Media Synopsis: On November 15, 2010, former North Olmsted Patrol Officer Brian Bielozer used the Ohio Law Enforcement Automated Data System ("LEADS") to look up personal information about his girlfriend's landlord Bielozer, now 42, of Westlake, used the LEADS information to locate and travel to the landlord's home in Westlake at approximately 2:30 a.m. Wearing his uniform, Bielozer threatened to pursue a criminal case against the landlord if they didn't return money that Bielozer claimed they owed his girlfriend. Media Synopsis: On March 23, 2012, a search warrant was executed by the Cleveland Police Narcotics Unit and the Ohio State Highway Patrol SWAT Unit at Jones's residence on Rowley Avenue in Cleveland. Taylor, then 38, of Cleveland, was arrested on scene for manufacturing methamphetamine. The lab was fully operational at the time of the search. Jones, then 34, of Cleveland, who was not present at the time of the search, was also charged with drug related offenses. On July 23, 2012, Taylor plead guilty to one count of Assembly/Possession of a Chemical Used for Manufacturing Drugs with the Intent to Manufacture and one count of Trafficking with forfeiture specifications. On August 13, 2012, Taylor was sentenced to 36 months of Community Control Sanctions and ordered to perform 200 hours of community work service.			

On December 22, 2015, Jones entered a plea of guilty to one count of Illegal Manufacture Or Cultivation of Drugs. She is scheduled to be sentenced at 9:00 am.
