Clark, Darius A. | Linnabary, Drew P.

Media Synopsis:

On May 28, 2015, Darius Clark, 28, was indicted for running a prostitution operation from behind bars at the Cuyahoga County Jail and charged with two counts of Promoting Prostitution. Also charged was Drew Phelps Linnabary, 27, who was instructed by Clark to recruit other women to work as prostitutes.

On January 21, 2016, Clark entered a plea of guilty to one count of Attempting Prostitution. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m.

In 2010, Clark was convicted in Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court of abusing two children, a three-year-old boy and a two-year-old girl. A jury found Clark guilty on five counts of Felonious Assault, two counts of Endangering Children and two counts of Domestic Violence. He was sentenced to 28 years in prison.

But the conviction was overturned on appeal. Clark's lawyers argued that the boy's preschool teacher should not have been allowed to testify at trial that the child had said Clark beat him. They said that testimony violated Clark's constitutional right to confront his accuser, and that when his teachers asked the child about the welts on the child's face, they were in effect acting as police officers.

The Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office argued the case before the high court in March 2015 on behalf of the State of Ohio. On June 18, 2015, the Supreme Court unanimously ruled that the preschool teacher's testimony regarding what the three-year-old abuse victim told her was properly admitted during the 2010 trial.

Clark has been in jail since September 2014 when he was arrested by Maple Heights police for attacking a 17-year-old girl at a Broadway Avenue nursing home where she worked. He has entered a plea of guilty and will be sentenced for the crimes committed in that case on February 10 as well.
