Primary Charges

Media Synopsis:

This case, along with cases 588031, 590402, 593787, and 587685, were joined to be tried together. The defendants in these cases committed a series of crimes during June and July 2014.

On June 23, 2014, Diaz- Alvarez, then 25, of Cleveland, shot the victim on the corner of West 25th and Trowbridge Avenue in Cleveland.

On July 11, 2014, Diaz-Alvarez fired at least ten shots into the home of his girlfriend's ex-boyfriend on West 93rd Street. One bullet came within twelve inches of a woman sleeping on the couch, however, no one was injured.

On July 21, 2014, on Meyer Avenue, Diaz-Alvarez shot an ex-boyfriend of his girlfriend (Colon, then 23, of Parma) in the hand while pretending to be a Cleveland policeman wearing a stolen uniform.

On that same day, Vandersspool, then 22, of Cleveland, and Rodriguez fatally shot a 44-year-old victim in the vicinity of 3131 West 46th Street in Cleveland during a carjacking.

Cleveland Police officers shot Diaz-Alvarez after he pointed a firearm at them. Rodriguez, then 29, of Cleveland also had a concealed firearm on him at the time.

Trial is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m.

On September 17, 2015 at 2877 Martin Luther King Boulevard, Ashley, then 50, of Cleveland, was involved in a verbal confrontation with his wife. This confrontation became physical and when his wife attempted to flee the home, Ashley tackled her and stabbed her multiple times with scissors. The victim was pronounced dead by EMS on scene.

Horton, Adaira P. | Fullilove, Dwayne V.

Media Synopsis:

On February 28, 2015, Horton, then 29, of Cleveland, shot her boyfriend in the torso after an argument. The victim was transported to Metro Health Hospital where he was pronounced dead. Horton's brother Fullilove, then 27, of Cleveland, was charged with obstructing justice for providing a false statement.

On January 25, 2016, Fullilove entered a plea of guilty to one count of Obstructing Official Business. He was sentenced to one year of community control.

On that same day, Horton entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Voluntary Manslaughter and Felonious Assault. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

The defendants robbed the Little Caesar's on Lorain Road in North Olmsted on November 22 and December 6 of 2015, while brandishing what appeared to be a firearm. They were captured about 10 minutes after the December 6th robbery traveling eastbound on I-480. A toy gun was found in the van as well as the cash register with the money still in it. This same toy gun was presumed to have been used in the November 22nd robbery. On Feb. 10, they pled guilty to the indictment: two counts each of Robbery.

On February 4, 2016, Hale entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Attempted Involuntary Manslaughter and Endangering Children. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On October 25, 2015, the 7/11 Convenience Store at 4901 Fleet Avenue in Cleveland, OH, was robbed at gunpoint. The robbery was captured on store security cameras. In connection with the incident, Terry Pendleton, 43, entered a plea of guilty on January 28, 2016, to Robbery, Having Weapons Under Disability, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Obstructing Official Business.

Media Synopsis:

On January 30, 2015 at the Club Fly High bar, 7019 Superior Avenue in Cleveland, Lash fatally shot the 30 year-old victim multiple times. The victim was transported to MetroHealth hospital where he died.

On February 12, 2016, a Cuyahoga County jury found Lash, 23, of Cleveland, guilty on eight counts, including Murder, Aggravated Murder, Felonious Assault, Illegal Possess of a Firearm in Liquor Permit Premises and Inducing Panic.
