## **Media Synopsis:**

On October 1, 2015 and October 13, 2015, the Ohio Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force received two Cybertips from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) indicating that an online user had transferred files containing known or suspected child pornography between various email accounts. Information contained within these Cybertips indicated that this activity occurred at an IP address associated with a business located in Oakwood Village, OH.

On December 3, 2015, the Ohio ICAC Task Force executed a search warrant at this business and identified Story, 35, of Bay Village, as a suspect after locating a desktop computer in his possession and within his personal workspace which contained known or suspected child pornography files, including some of the files contained within the NCMEC Cybertip.

On March 8, 2016, Story entered a plea of guilty to 41 counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material Or Performance, 27 counts of Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor and one count of Possessing Criminal Tools.

## **Media Synopsis:**

In 2002, Hernandez, now 53, of Cleveland, kidnapped his son and brought him to Cleveland where they lived under false identities for 13 years.

On November 2, 2015, Hernandez was contacted by detectives of the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Office. Hernandez identified himself as Jonathan Mangina and provided an Ohio driver's license. A fingerprint examiner conducted a fingerprint comparison between known fingerprints of Bobby Hernandez and those obtained from Jonathan Mangina at the time of his arrest. It was determined they are the same person.

On March 14, 2016, Hernandez entered a plea of guilty to two counts of Kidnapping, 10 counts of Tampering with Records, two counts of Interference with Custody and one count of Forgery.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m.

Defendant Floyd, 20, of Cleveland, was found guilty on March 7, 2016 of Aggravated Robbery, Kidnapping, Having Weapons Under Disability and Theft in connection with four separate incidents of armed robberies and carjackings that occurred during September of 2015. Those crimes took place in the parking lots of two Giant Eagle stores, outside Heck's Cafe in Ohio City and on the campus of Case Western Reserve University.
