During his crime spree, defendant robbed a bakery, a bank and two restaurants, all at gunpoint. Sentencing is set to begin at 10 a.m.

<b>Media Synopsis:</b> Jason Story, 36, of Bay Village, was downloading and sharing child pornography via his e-mail account at his place of employment, Story Equipment Sales, in Oakwood. Story admitted to using the internet at work to view pornography and that he is attracted to children in pictures. ICAC Investigators found hundreds of images and videos on Story's work computer. He subsequently plead guilty to 29 Felony 2 Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor and Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity Oriented Material charges as well as 40 other felony charges. Sentencing is set to begin at 8:30 a.m.

**Media Synopsis:**

Defendants faced a variety of charges stemming from their involvement the Detroit Taking Over or DTO gang. The gang was indicted with several incidents related to automobiles stolen on the West Side of Cleveland and the surrounding suburbs during the summer and fall of 2015.

On April 27, Barnes, 20, of Cleveland, entered a plea of guilty to Criminal Gang Activity, Burglary and Receiving Stolen Property (Motor Vehicle). That same day, Acoff, 23, of Cleveland, entered a plea of guilty to Receiving Stolen Property.

Both are scheduled to be sentenced on May 23 at 10:30 a.m.

On April 27, Laster entered a plea of guilty to Criminal Gang Activity, Robbery and Attempted Receiving Stolen Property.

He is scheduled to be sentenced On May 25 at 10:30 a.m.

When police attempted to question him, he refused to cooperate and struggled with the officers. On April 25, defendant Padgett, 36, of Cleveland, entered a plea of guilty to one count each of Assault on a Peace Officer and Criminal Damaging.
