Media Synopsis: On August 13, 2015, Brian Naylor was intoxicated and spinning the tires in a 1978 Ford Pinto that was modified for racing in the driveway of a home in Strongsville. He lost control of the car and hit his father, Delmar Naylor, and his father's friend, Thomas Beaune. Both men were transported to the hospital and later died of their injuries. On May 23, Brian Naylor pled guilty to Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, Aggravated Vehicular Assault and Driving While Under the Influence. Sentencing is scheduled for 10 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On December 21, 2013, Hicks, now 38, was with the victim, his wife, leaving a bar in the early hours of the morning. They argued, and he shot the victim twice, killing her. Hicks pushed the victim out of the car onto the street, and then drove to his father's house where he confessed to his father and tried to get rid of the gun. On October 20, 2014, a jury found Hicks, who is now 38, guilty of Aggravated Murder, Murder and other related charges and specifications. He was sentenced to life without parole.

On December 3, 2015, the 8th Court of Appeals overturned the Aggravated Murder conviction and remanded the case for resentencing on the Murder conviction.

Sentencing is scheduled for 1:30 p.m.
