Media Synopsis:

On August 29, 2007, Fairview Park Fire Department responded to a house fire on W. 220th Street where the body of the homeowner, 67-year-old Gwendolyn Bewley, was found dead on the kitchen floor.

Sheline, 56, of Fairview Park, is accused of murdering the victim then intentionally setting the house on fire.

Sheline and Bewley began a friendship several months prior to the incident and Sheline used that connection to make unauthorized purchases with the victim's credit and PayPal accounts.

Media Synopsis:

October 10, 2015, Mister A. Jackson, a Cleveland Police Officer, bit the victim on the right side of her chest causing a visible mark. When the victim attempted to leave the scene, Jackson stood in front of the driver's side door with a firearm in hand.

The victim got into her vehicle through the passenger door, and when she attempted to leave, the defendant climbed into the vehicle and grabbed the steering wheel, causing the vehicle to strike a house.

Media Synopsis:

The 22-year-old defendant was found in possession of numerous stolen items of women's undergarments, sportswear, and jewelry. The items were taken from laundry rooms and residence halls at Notre Dame College and from homes in Westlake and South Euclid.

The defendant, a student at Notre Dame College, hid the items in the ceiling of the suite in which he resided. Police recovered 656 items of stolen property with an aggregate value of approximately \$11,818.

On December 12, Zinram pled guilty to one count of Theft and two counts of Receiving Stolen Property.

Media Synopsis:

The State charges that early on the morning of July 20, 2015, the three defendants forced their way at gunpoint into an apartment on Wheelock Road that was occupied by four adults and a 3-year-old child. During the ensuing robbery, the 22-year-old victim was shot and killed.

On May 6, co-defendants Townsend and Simmons entered pleas of guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter, Aggravated Burglary, Aggravated Robbery and Felonious Assault. They will sentenced at later date.

The trial of Ladson is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On August 23, 2015, the defendants approached victim Fredrick McIntosh, 43, and a female while they were parked in a vehicle on Capers Avenue in Cleveland.

Baylor, then 17, approached the passenger's side which was occupied by the victim; Cleveland, then 15, approached the driver's side and demanded money.

Baylor was attempting to go through the victim's pockets when an altercation ensued. Cleveland then reached through the driver's window and fatally shot McIntosh in the back.

On November 21, Baylor pled guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter with firearm specifications, Aggravated Robbery and Tampering with Evidence.

On November 23, Cleveland pled guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter with firearm specifications, Aggravated Robbery and Tampering with Evidence.

Sentencing for both defendants is schedule to begin at 8:30 a.m.
