**Media Synopsis:**

On three separate occasions, defendant, 31, broke into the home of the then-79-year-old female victim.

The first incident occurred on June 28, 2016, when the defendant posed as a city worker. At gunpoint the defendant duct taped the victim in her basement and then stole her debit card, a computer, and her cell phone.

On July 15, the defendant returned and forced the victim to give him money.

He returned on July 29, at which time he entered the victim's home, tied her up, and stole her cell phone, computer, cash, and her car.

The next day, Shaker Heights Police Department arrested the defendant after spotting the stolen vehicle.

Judith Nagy, 52, ran the non-profit business Specialized Group Services, which provided employment for people with development disabilities. From 2012 through 2014 the defendant stole over \$800,000 in cash from the business and also bounced over 150 payroll checks. The checks were issued to 42 individuals with special needs who were employed by her non-profit business.

She also never paid back an individual loan nor rent for leased business space after bouncing checks from an account with insufficient funds.

On May 1, Nagy pled guilty to Aggravated Theft and Theft. She also agreed to pay restitution in the amount of \$15,000.

Nagy was also placed on the State Abuser Registry and will never be able to work again with individuals who are developmentally disabled.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin Monday morning.

**Media Synopsis:**

On Saturday, July 9, 2016, the 20-year-old defendant drove in excess of the posted speed limit westbound on Kirby Avenue in Cleveland and lost control of the vehicle. He struck a large tree and the car spun in a clockwise direction, ejecting four of the five passengers onto the roadway.

The accident caused the deaths of three 17-year-old victims: Alexandria Winegarner, Daija Lynne, and Takia Jackson. The accident also caused serious injuries to two minor females, ages 14 and 15.
