**Media Synopsis:**

On August 6, 2016, at the intersection of North Taylor Rd. and Euclid Ave. the defendant, then 35, was under the influence of alcohol and driving recklessly. He crashed into a motorcycle driven by the 52-year-old victim. The victim died as a result of his injuries and his female passenger fractured her wrist.

Defendants engaged in smash and grab activity including aggravated robbery at a Gas USA. Their van smashed into the building while defendant Jones and others on the scene held the employees at gunpoint while the ATM was stolen from inside the store.

During his trial on May 4, defendant Jones pled guilty Breaking & Entering, Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, Aggravated Robbery, Failure to Comply, and Receiving Stolen Property.

Banks, Ward, Warner, and Garner previously pled guilty to the charges Breaking & Entering, Vandalism, Grand Theft, and Safecracking.

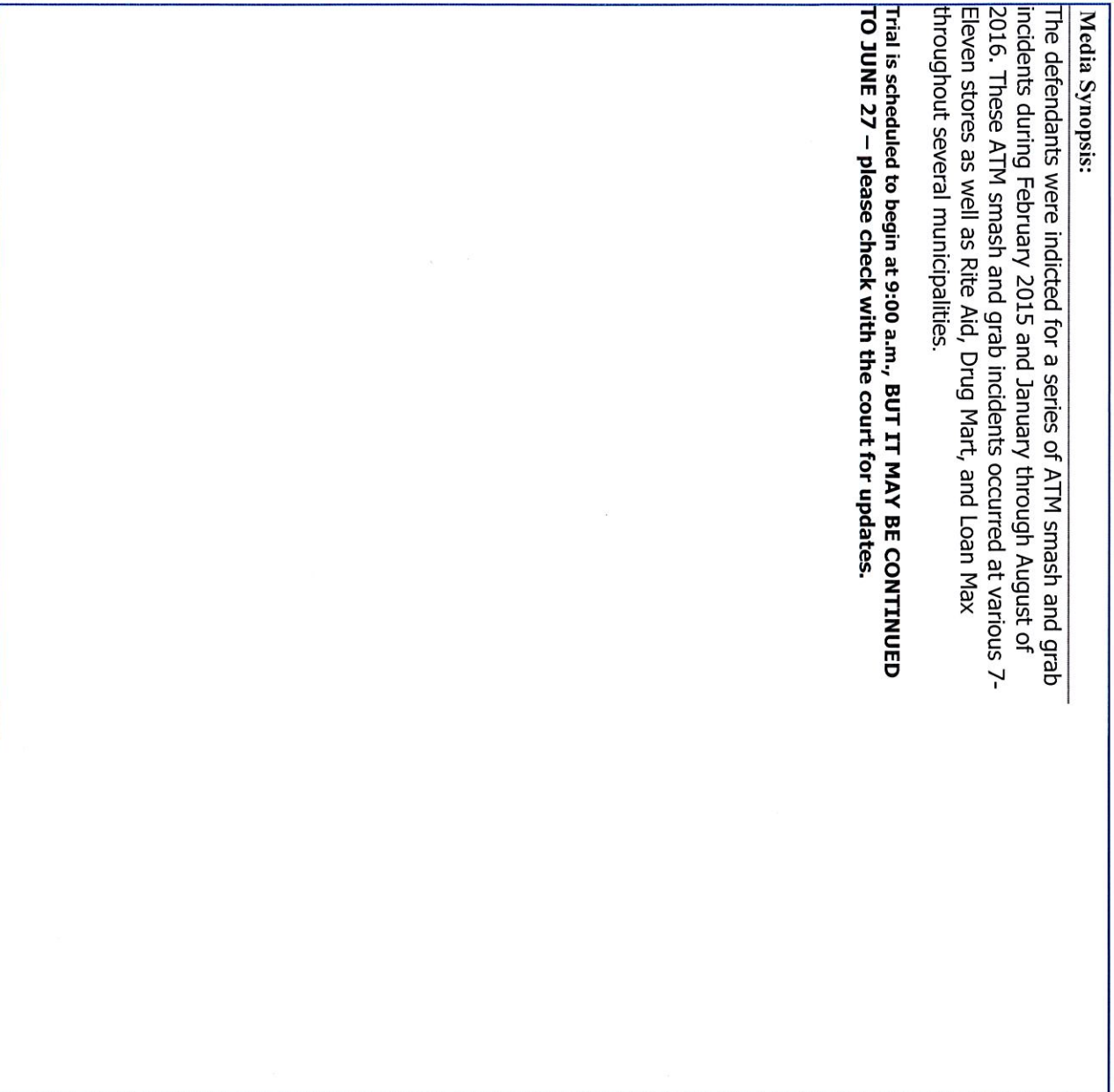
Sentencing will be held at 1:15 p.m. on June 26.

The defendants were indicted for a series of ATM smash and grab incidents during February 2015 and January through August of 2016. These ATM smash and grab incidents occurred at various 7-Eleven stores as well as Rite Aid, Drug Mart, and Loan Max throughout several municipalities.

**Media Synopsis:**

On January 18, 2017 eight separate crimes that occurred in the same Shaker Heights neighborhood, consisting of four residential burglaries, one garage break-in and three criminal trespassing.

Newton pled guilty on June 8, 2017 to Burglary, Attempted Burglary, and Breaking and Entering.
