Media Synopsis:

On June 9, 1996, Defendant grabbed a female victim at the intersection of East 55th Street and Scovill Avenue and drove the victim to his residence in Cleveland and sexually assaulted her.

On December 2, 1998, the defendant committed a similar sexually assault on a second victim.

On November 20, 2013, BCI found the defendant's DNA from a separate incident matched the DNA profile pulled from the first victim's rape kit. In 2015, analysis matched the defendant's DNA to that of the second victim.

On August 27, the defendant pled guilty to one count of Rape and one count of Rape with a Repeat Violent Offender specification.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m.

The evening of June 4, 2017, three 14-year-olds, two female and one male, were at Kurtz Park in Parma Heights. The Defendant, 24, approached the girls and told them they were "hot". As they walked away, the defendant exposed himself and grabbed one of the female's breast and buttock. The male victim pushed the defendant away from her. The defendant fled when the male victim's mother drove into the park.

Moments later, the defendant approached a female who lives near the park, struck up a conversation, and proceeded to masturbate in front of her. He ran off when he saw police lights. After a short foot pursuit, Parma Heights police apprehended the

defendant.

On August 23, the defendant pled to Gross Sexual Imposition and Public Indecency.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On March 18, 2017, a female victim, 34, was awakened by the defendant, whom she had been dating for several months. The defendant, 35, accused her of cheating on him. He choked her, struck her in the head several times, and sexually assaulted her. He then demanded money he knew to be in the safe. He left and returned to his apartment, which was next door.

While awaiting trial, the defendant solicited the help of another inmate to break into the victim's apartment and steal more money and items. He provided specific details about the victim, her possessions, and the best time to commit the burglary.

On August 23, the defendant pled to Attempted Rape, Felonious Assault, Aggravated Burglary, Grand Theft, Aggravated Menacing, and Conspiracy.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.
