Media Synopsis: Between February 2002 and January 2017, the defendant stole over \$118,000 worth of blue-ray DVDs, music CDs, box sets, and other miscellaneous materials while employed as a delivery driver for the Cuyahoga County Public Library. During the investigation, the stolen items were recovered from the Defendant's car and home by the Parma Police. Nearly \$81,000 worth of recovered items were put back into the Library's circulation. The remaining items, valued at \$36,998, cannot be placed back into circulation due to damage and/or items missing from the collections. On July 20, the 43-year-old defendant pled to Theft in Office. Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m.

Media Synopsis:

On July 21, 2017, a jury found the defendant guilty of Rape, Complicity to Commit Rape, and two counts of Kidnapping for an incident that took place in May of 1997. The Defendant and another male, who is still unknown, robbed and sexually assaulted a female victim.

In 2016, the Sexual Assault Kit Task Force submitted the victim's untested rape kit to BCI. The crime was linked back to the defendant, who also has a Human Trafficking case pending in Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas.

Media Synopsis:

The 18-year-old defendant stole or attempted to steal four cars in 10 days. The first was a stolen Accura late on February 11, 2017, from the CVS on West Blvd. A few hours later he attempted to steal an Uber at Gas USA on West 117.

A week later, he and a 15-year-old juvenile brandished a fake gun to steal a Jeep at a Walgreens at West 138 and Lorain. They later attempted to steal a manual Mustang GT - but were unable to drive it. The victim's iPhone was stolen from the vehicle.

The iPhone tracker led authorities to an RTA station. The RTA Police watched the suspects in real-time as they boarded a train. Once on the train, RTA locked the train down at the West Park Rapid Station. Cleveland Police arrived and apprehended the defendant and juvenile.

On July 12, the defendant pled guilty to Robbery.

Media Synopsis:

Between June and October 2015, the Ohio ICAC Task Force identified an IP address on London Road in Cleveland as a download candidate for known or suspected child pornography. The task force was able to download the illicit files and identified them as being associated with a computer or electronic device at that location.

A search warrant was executed and identified the 41-year-old defendant as the suspect. Hundreds of files of child pornography were found, including files on hard drives dating back to 2008.

At trial, the defendant was convicted of 90 of the indicted 95 counts including Pandering Sexually Oriented Material Involving a Minor, Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, and Illegal Use of Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 10:00am.
