Media Synopsis:

On or about January 26, 2017, the defendant, 44, kidnapped and murdered 14-year-old Alianna DeFreeze while she was on her way to school. On January 29, 2017, the victim's remains were found in an abandoned home on Fuller Avenue in Cleveland.

On February 13, a Cuyahoga County Jury found the defendant guilty of Aggravated Murder, Rape, Kidnapping, Aggravated Burglary, Tampering with Evidence, and Gross Abuse of a Corpse.

On February 23, the Jury unanimously recommended the death penalty.

Sentencing is scheduled to begin at 11:00 a.m.

Media Synopsis:

On October 10, 2017, defendants Bradley, age 20, and Jones, age 22, along with Antonio Ponyard Jr., and Johnigan Reeves, participated in a smash and grab of an ATM in Broadview Heights. Officers tried to initiate a traffic stop and a chase ensued. The van crashed in Middleburg Heights. Ponyard Jr., 21, and Reeves, 22, died at the scene. The stolen ATM was found inside the van.

On January 31, Jones pled to Breaking and Entering, Vandalism, Safecracking, Receiving Stolen Property, and Theft. He was sentenced to two years in prison.

Trial for Bradley is expected to begin at 8:30 a.m.

She crashed into another vehicle, which caused a chain reaction of collisions involving five cars. The 70-year-old driver of the first car she hit sustained serious physical harm
