## **Requirements:**

- Bring a copy of each child's birth certificate
- Bring a copy of each child's social security card or a refusal letter
- Bring Proof of Paternity for each child (e.g. marriage license, CSEA document, copy of court order, Paternity Acknowledgement registry number).
- For a Grandparent Power of Attorney, both parents must be present. If only one parent can be present with the grandparent, reasonable efforts must be made to locate and provide notice to the other parent, and you have been unable to locate that parent; unless the other parent is prohibited from receiving notice, or the parental rights of the other parent have been terminated by order of a Juvenile Court.
